PSALM 19 – JOHN WHARTON

LEADER: The law of the LORD is perfect;

LEADER: The decrees of the LORD are steadfast;

PEOPLE: they give wisdom to the simple.

LEADER: The precepts of the LORD are right;

PEOPLE: they gladden the heart.

LEADER: The command of the LORD is clear;

PEOPLE: it gives light to the eyes.

LEADER: The fear of the LORD is pure, abiding forever.

PEOPLE: The judgments of the LORD are true; they are, all of them, just.

ALL: May the spoken words of my mouth, the thoughts of my heart, win favor in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer!



1 CORINTHIANS 11:23-29 JOHN LOVE – LORD’S SUPPER

LEADER: For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread,

PEOPLE: And when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, “This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”

LEADER: In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.”

PEOPLE: For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

LEADER: Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty concerning the body and blood of the Lord.

PEOPLE Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself.



PSALM 99 – BILL HEMPHILL

LEADER: The LORD reigns,

PEOPLE: let the nations tremble;

LEADER: He sits enthroned between the cherubim,

PEOPLE: let the earth shake.

LEADER: Great is the LORD in Zion;

PEOPLE: he is exalted over all the nations.

LEADER: Enter his gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise;

PEOPLE: give thanks to Him and praise His name.

ALL: For the Lord is good and His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations.
