Life Group notes:

Share:

- What has been the greatest act of love you have seen personally?
- If the hairs on our heads are each numbered what does that say about God's attention to detail?

Study:

- Take a moment and reflect over the sermon notes. Discuss what point or passage of scripture most challenged, confused or caught your attention today and why?
- Of the four ways to love others like Jesus: forgive, accept, value, and believe, which one will be the most difficult for you to do and why?
- Where can a person, rejected by their parents, go for acceptance as stated in Psalm 27:10?
- How does God's love compare with a parent's love?
- I Corinthians 13:1-3 explains the importance of love. Are there things that you concentrate on that keep you from being loving?
- In Mark 10:17-22 we have the story of the rich young ruler. In verse 21 it says, "Jesus looked at him and loved him". What do you think that means for us today?

Support:

- We all have things in our lives that make us difficult to love. Jesus showed us acceptance, and now we can show someone else that same acceptance. Who do you know that is hard to love?
- What are some ways to show a person acceptance this week with a small gesture of love?
- Take some time to show love to members of your group by what you value in each other?
- How would you go about forgiving someone who hurt you or encouraging someone that is burdened by hanging on to guilt?

Serve:

- Which of the four actions steps are you going to accomplish this week? Do you think it is possible to accomplish them all every day?
- How can we make loving others the way that Jesus loves us a habit in our lives?
