Life Groups

Now that you have had your first meeting, let me remind you of the purpose of Life Groups (LG)

SHARE

Each week we'll take time to share what is happening in our lives.

STUDY

Each week we'll study a section from God's Word that relates to our theme, "Discipleship" coming from lessons presented from a sermon previously preached.

Our goal is to interact interpersonally on the topic and how we can practically follow Christ, not to answer all the questions.

SUPPORT

Each week we'll learn how to take care of one another as Christ commanded (John 15:9-13).

This care can take many forms, such as prayer, encouragement, listening, challenging one another, and meeting real needs.

SERVE

Spiritual growth is fostered not only by what we gain through the support and input of others, but also through service to others. The role each of us fills is important to the health of the Church and for us to be the hands and feet of Jesus to our community (Ephesians 4:11-16).

Throughout this series, it is our hope you can find and/or be affirmed in the ways God has designed you to serve and make a difference in God's Kingdom.

SHARE

1. What is the best thing that happened to you this week?
2. Where did you see God this week?

STUDY

1. Matthew 28:18–20 says that we are to be disciples that make disciples. Read the passage and discuss what that looks like for you? It's okay if you are not sure.
2. I Corinthians 13:4-7 defines biblical love for us. What areas do you struggle with and what areas do you tend to do better with? Give some examples.
3. God defines biblical love in 3 ways
 - A. Biblical love isn't an emotion, but an action. Matthew 5:44–45a
 - B. Biblical love gives more than it gets. Proverbs 11:25–26
 - C. Biblical love doesn't take advantage of relationships. Proverbs 25:17Give some examples of how you have seen these played out in a Christian person.

SUPPORT

Take a minute to share with one another how you can be supportive of each one in the LG. Use this time for prayer requests and encouraging each other.

SERVE

Pick an activity or a service project for you to do as a group. It can be a one-time event, a project over several weeks, or a weekly venture that you'll do until the LG break.
