Discipleship During Discouraging Times

One aspect of discipleship is helping to build each other up in our faith. This can be especially important when a fellow Christian has experienced a discouragement of some kind.

Share

Tell about someone you know who has recently been discouraged by an event in their life. Use discretion if this is not a commonly known situation.

Study

Psalms 34:17-19 tells us that the Lord is always there for us in times of discouragement. Other than just quoting the verse, what are ways we can remind a discouraged Christian that the Lord is always there?

In Isaiah 40 30-31 we are told that everyone will grow weary, but that the Lord will renew our strength and give us “wings like eagles”. Talk about how that can be seen in real examples of the Christian’s walk.

Support

How can Christians help others (especially other Christians) cope/get through bad times? Is there a “light” at the end of the “tunnel of troubles”? What is it, and how can we help others see it?

Serve

Think of someone you know in our congregation who needs encouragement right for any reason (illness, weak in the faith, shut-in, overwhelmed with work or other aspects of life). What are some ways we can encourage this person, other than the traditional phone call or card?
